### Internship Information

The National HEP/CAMP Association has partnered with the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) to offer a 10-week summer internship in Washington, D.C. to students from farmworker backgrounds. Interns will work 40 hours/week in various USDA Agencies.

### Eligibility

Applicant must currently be enrolled in a post-secondary institute or recent graduate and meet one of the following criteria:

- Former or current CAMP student
- HEP graduate

Candidates must be able to independently work and live in D.C.

Complete Application Form:

- Resume
- Two letters of recommendation
- School transcript

### Selected participants will receive:

- Round-trip transportation to Washington, D.C.
- Housing at George Washington University
- Up to \$6,800 Stipend
- Transportation subsidy for employment
- Networking, social and cultural experiences in D.C.
