ABOUT US

EDUCATION

The High School Equivalency Program (HEP) and the College Assistance Migrant Program (CAMP) have existed since 1967 and 1972, respectively.

HEP and CAMP are educational programs which serve students from migrant or seasonal farmworker families. HEP helps students who have dropped out of high school get their High School Equivalency Credential, and serves more than 6,000 students annually. CAMP assists students in their first year of college with academic, personal, and financial support. CAMP serves approximately 2,400 migrant participants annually. Overall, nearly three-quarters of all CAMP students graduate with baccalaureate degrees.

These two programs, which have achieved stunning success rates since their inception, are funded through grants from the U.S. Department of Education, Office of Migrant Education and are administered by universities, colleges and non-profit organizations nationwide.

The National HEP/CAMP Association is an organization whose membership is comprised of universities, colleges and non-profit organizations that administer a HEP and/or a CAMP Project. The Association's membership is committed to improving the quality and effectiveness of the national HEP and CAMP program, all HEP and CAMP projects, and to disseminating information about HEP and CAMP.

SPONSORSHIPS

DC Internship

The National HEP/CAMP Association funds several interns each year who are placed with various offices in Washington D.C., many of which are on Capitol Hill. This is a once-in-a-lifetime experience for HEP and CAMP students.

Six CAMP students or HEP graduates in their first year at a post-secondary institution are selected to participate in The National HEP/CAMP Association Internship Program. The selected participants travel to Washington, D.C. to take part in a ten-week internship. Expected internship placements include congressional offices, the Office of Migrant Education, United Farm Workers, United States Department of Agriculture, and the White House Initiative on Educational Excellence for Hispanic Americans.

HEP/CAMP Scholarship

The HEP/CAMP scholarship is designed to help students cover the costs of attendance as they attend or transition into studies at the post-secondary level. Over 20 scholarship recipients are selected annually, the scholarship amount ranges between \$1,000 to \$2,000 each.

Student Emergency Fund (SEF)

The National HEP/CAMP Association has funded a Student Emergency Fund (SEF). Participants of HEP or CAMP projects who are experiencing financial hardships are eligible to apply for financial support. This initiative is on its initial steps; however, nearly \$30,000 have been distributed to students who have needed the financial assistance.
